Our mission: we exist to support mothers in their spiritual growth, stages of parenting, Catholic teachings and fellowship.

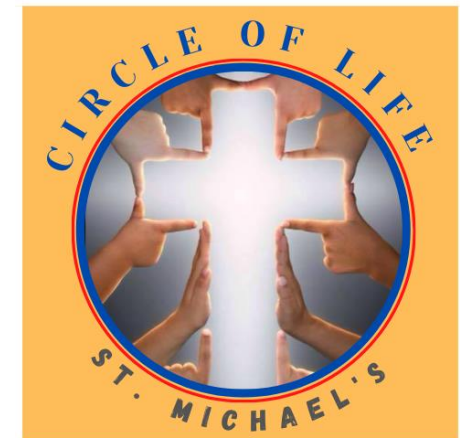
