
Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO) Faith Study Series

Adults sometimes find themselves stuck in a childhood understanding or misunderstanding of some aspect of their faith especially if they have not had any opportunity for ongoing adult faith formation. The CCO Faith Studies in a parish setting can help us to mature spiritually and even become equipped for mission in a variety of ways.

But first of all - what is CCO? "CCO is a Catholic movement that raises up Christ-centred, Spirit-filled leaders to evangelize the world one person at a time. CCO's mission is rooted on university campuses, includes alumni, parishes, dioceses, and other key Church and global partners." (Mission Statement: 2024)

Faith Studies here at St. Michael's offer us the opportunity to grow deeper in our Catholic faith. Each lesson is a step on the path towards greater maturity in our call to holiness and in our readiness to fulfill our baptismal call to serve the Church's Great Commission of evangelization.

<u>The Discovery Faith Study</u> invites participants to encounter Christ through a simple but challenging look at the Gospel message. Participants learn the foundation of our Christian beliefs and what it means to put **Jesus at the centre of our lives**.



<u>The Trust Faith Study</u> helps to inspire participants to relate to God as a good Father who is eminently trustworthy and to dispel fears to live in greater freedom. Too often people are slowed in their spiritual growth or even turn away from God because of a lack of trust.

<u>Commission</u> focuses on revealing the church's deepest identity, which is Her missionary character. The lessons examine truths and principles about evangelization and discipleship that have been learned over years of active missionary engagement.

The hope of these Faith Studies is that we be better equipped to mature as Catholics in our faith and be given the tools to enable us to act on the great mission Jesus gave to ALL his disciples, "to go and make disciples of all nations: (Matthew 28:18)


